Month wise breakup of the training with the methodology adopted

The project was started on 1st January, 2009 and ended on 30th April, 2009. The training module included First Aid, Home nursing, Blood pressure checkup, Injection, blood collection and dietetics and nutrition. A number of equipments were used during training period such as Blood pressure machine, stethoscope, injection syringe, microscope, etc. The trainees received practical training on blood sample collection, blood pressure checkups, etc.
